







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#### BC revisited


- A central node/edge has an impact on information flow in a network
- A common centrality measure is BC
- The ratio for the number of the shortest paths travelled through an arbitrary element and the number of all shortest path between those nodes, calculated for all node pairs.



$$BC(X) = \sum \left(\frac{P(a,b|X)}{P(a,b)}\right)$$

#### **BC** revisited

- A central node/edge has an impact on information flow in a network
- A common centrality measure is BC
- The ratio for the number of the shortest paths travelled through an arbitrary element and the number of all shortest path between those nodes, calculated for all node pairs
- High BC residues are important for protein function





## Community detection


- Community analysis shows closeknit groups in a network
- A community is a group of nodes that connected to each other, without an edge to outer nodes
- Girvan-Newman algorithm removes the most central (highest BC) edge one-by-one and searches for communities



- 1. Calculate edge BC
- 2. Remove the edge with highest BC
- 3. Check for emergence of new communities
- 4. Return to step 1 and iterate

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


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## Community composition

 Assessing the composition of communities and scoring the structural origins of members shed light on communication between the segments

$$\Omega = 3$$



Blue and Black together in a community in this instance so the score is 1.
